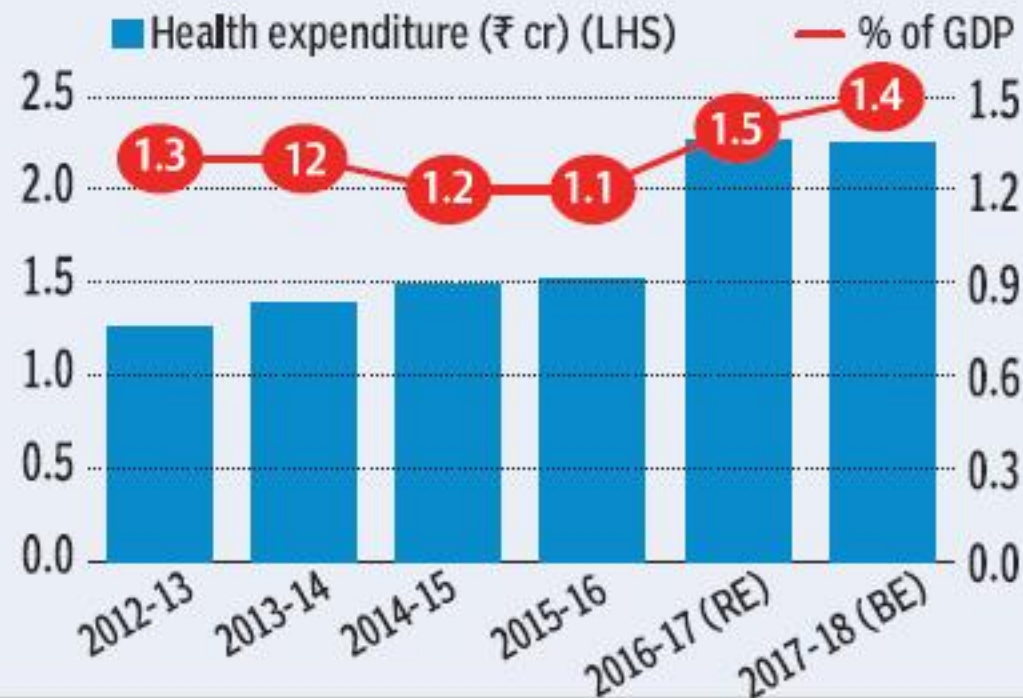


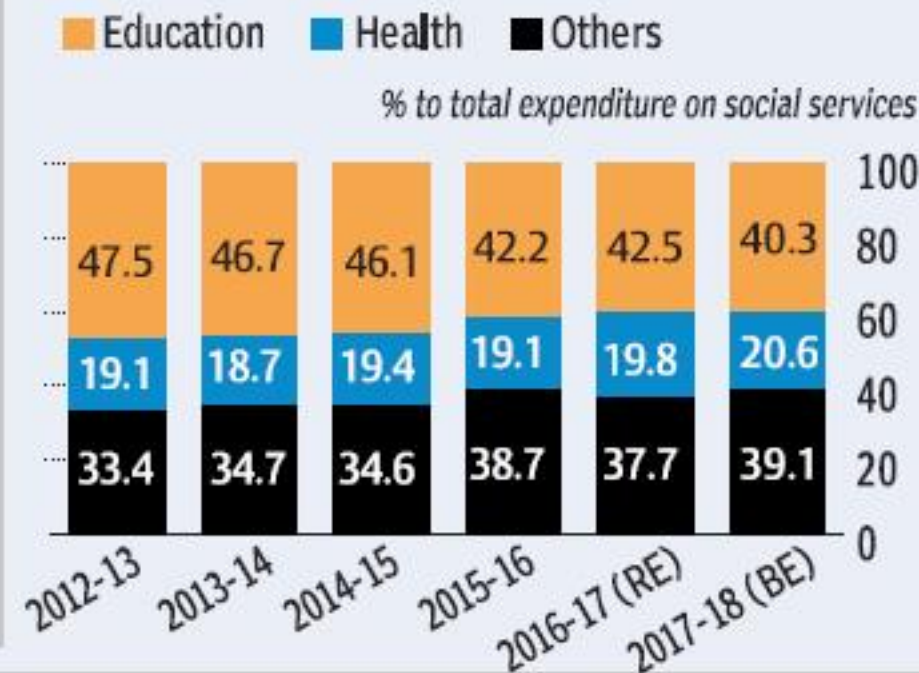
# Health needs urgent care

The allocation to the healthcare sector has seen a meagre rise of 2 per cent in the recent budget. This is affecting mortality rates and health

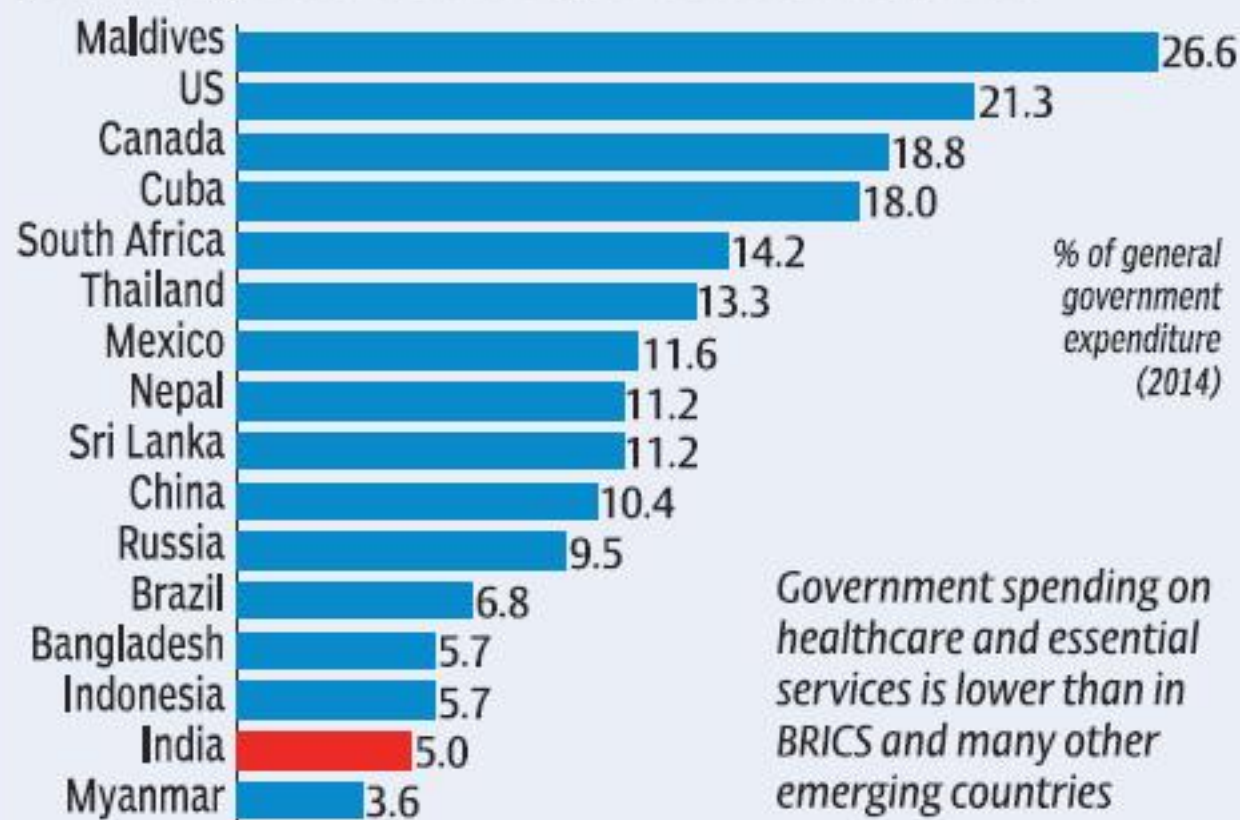
## Not in step with GDP growth

India	217	18.6	23.3
South Africa	834	3.1	26.5

\*Death as % of infected people

Noncommunicable diseases are cardiovascular disease, cancer, diabetes or chronic respiratory disease
